

WCS final Report

The Institute for Advanced Studies and Cooperation (IASC) has always operated focusing on the implementation of cutting-edge projects. In 2022 his board became aware of the enormous possibilities offered by an interdisciplinary meeting between the members of the various projects, and of the importance that this event would assume in a unique and emblematic venue such as the Pontifical Academy of Sciences. We then proceeded to verify the feasibility of this ambitious project, working on three main directives: technological innovation, cell regeneration, economy. On these three directives developed according to an ethical, moral and interdisciplinary vision, the summit was built. In the idea of the organizers there was the desire for the participation of the Vatican authorities and representatives of the various institutional sectors of this centuries-old and venerated institution. Discussion and development tables could have been opened, receiving guidelines and making available the top experts in the strategic sectors covered at the summit. The idea of "immersing" scientific research in a framework of faith and history was intended to be the proof of an effort that goes beyond the will and the individual and builds a horizon of growth and prosperity in communion. This convivial aspect was underlined by the formal nature of the lunch and the desire to create amazement and inspiration through the private visit to the Vatican Museums and finally meet in the museum gardens for a final aperitif. For the first time, a digital Summit space has been created in the metaverse. The website and the work of "connection" between the Institute, its advisors and the WCS has been designed to give continuity and prominence to the work. The interventions were all video-recorded and will be the subject of a detailed report. From the summit reports emerged concrete solutions to current problems and the importance of interdisciplinary conferences and scientific comparisons.

RESULTS

The interdisciplinary meetings and comparisons that took place both during the summit and during the various aggregative moments gave immediate and tangible results. Last but not least, the decision to create an event on the fundamental importance of the female figure in society, taking inspiration from the work of the Holy Father. In order to give concrete value to this intent, collaboration with the PAS was immediately sought in the person of Renv.mo Monsignor Viganò, vice-chancellor of this important institution. The convergence of so much energy, hopes, work immediately made it possible to fix the date of October 13, book the private visit to the museums and fix the press presentation at the Pontifical Chancellery on October 12. "World Changers Power Women's Summit" was born under the best auspices and intentions. The willingness to continue building the annual WCS path at the PAS and to carry out other international events in order to further enhance the message of the WCS and interdisciplinary collaborations between states and institutions was also confirmed. Central is the leading role of the ecclesiastical authorities in the implementation of common strategies that lead the Institute of Advanced Studies and Cooperation to optimize efforts for WCS growth and affirm the increasingly central role of the Church in building a more inclusive economy, in the development of scientific research, and in guiding young people towards a conscious use of new technologies. The World Changers Power Women's Summit maintains the same technical-scientific character as the WCS despite having chosen different main themes such as Leadership, Innovation, Collaboration. In the days following the WCS, efforts were made to present to His Holiness and to the competent authorities innovative projects resulting from discussions between the participants in the work. One of these projects involves world-renowned experts for the implementation of an inclusive Vatican financial policy, which can propose an aggregative model of world unity, which can at the same time propose a high spiritual, symbolic and economic value. This is how the UNITY COIN project was born, which we report below in abbreviated and exemplary form. Dr. Alexandru Darnea, former IASC Director of Digital Transition, and an exceptional consultant: Sir. Dustin Planthold, have been appointed to carry out the project.

Introduction on the UnityCoin project

The Holy Father: "Money must serve, not govern!" in the words of Pope Francis resonates the goal of the Unity Coin, which is not to govern financial systems, but to be at the service of the people to create an inclusive, equitable and sustainable economy. Here is the Coin Unity. The potential Vatican cryptocurrency stablecoin aimed at strengthening and stabilizing global economic unity. It transcends geopolitical boundaries, aligning with the Vatican's mission of peace, justice and solidarity. The spiritual, social and economic importance of the project is understood by taking as a reference case: Tether (USDT) with 4.4 million coin holders generated revenues in excess of \$1.48 billion USD per year. Given the Vatican's global

influence and Catholic population of more than \$1.3 billion, even if Unity Coin achieves only 10% of Tether's success, it could generate an approximate \$148 million USD per year profit. These potential revenues could heal the Vatican's budget deficit that amounted to \$37M Euro by 2022 turning it into a positive trend, and producing a possible surplus of about \$111 million USD. A diversified underlying for the Unity Coin can optimize its stability, minimize its risk and ensure its alignment with the purpose of the coin and the resources and values of the Vatican. As a leader in promoting peace, justice and solidarity, the Vatican's adoption of blockchain technology through Unity Coin would set a global precedent, an example to be followed for the realization of a technology at the service of the common good that promotes financial inclusion and economic stability worldwide.

Another element that emerged during the conference is the possibility of creating spaces concerning the metaverse, a fundamental theme to get closer to the youngest, a dimension that today more than ever must not be left unexplored, especially in anticipation of the Jubilee. Among the various projects exhibited on the metaverse besides the one created by the Gamioun company for the WCS, we note with interest the project "iDio: Your Ultimate Christian Companion" work explores the theme of pilgrimages with captivating graphics, embraces spirituality, visits churches and more. iDio optimizes the possible journey through guided tours, daily reflections, virtual tours and supportive community. It deepens the themes of faith and religiosity, strengthening the feeling of belonging and affirming the cohesion and unity of the Church. in places of worship offering assistance hitherto unthinkable. We believe this project is in strong synergy with the creation of the "Unity Coin" and that it can implement its strength and spiritual value. iDio is in tune with a wide range of platforms, including iOS, Android Technologies, Mixed Reality (MR) and Virtual Reality (VR), the application will also be perfectly compatible with the new Apple glasses. Dr. Alexandru Darnea, conceived and developed this project with a significant ideological and spiritual inclination, which highlighted the key role that the Christian and Catholic community assumes in the technological and ideological field. The IASC was happy to be able to accept this important proposal during the work of the WCS and is actively working to make this project happen.

At the summit, thanks to the collaboration with Dr. Rahm, the Institute of Advanced Studies and Cooperation was able to sign an agreement in principle for the optimization, production and distribution of devices that exploit the "Holographic Information Transfer" technology developed and successfully carried out by researcher Dario Spera. Through this new agreement, Evolutionary Biohacking takes yet another step towards the realization of an inclusive holistic integrated preventive medicine of cell regeneration. This was possible thanks also to the creation by the institute of an informative volume distributed during the conference Evolutionary Biohacking and the Raise of A.I. in regenerative science.

Conclusions

We believe we can say that the works for the realization of the WCS have been a great organizational and collaborative effort that has seen us grow and improve together. If it is true that as individuals we have failed, I believe it is equally true that as brothers we have shown that we can rise again. Our commitment continues and we sincerely thank all those who in any way have contributed to this success of the soul.

We reaffirm our commitment and will continue to work so that the next appointments of 13 October 2023 and that of 5 July 2024 can be equally generous with results.
